

OGILVIE ROOMS – built in the 1920's

This venue is located on Commercial Street with the entrance between the museum and a small grocer's shop. It is across the road from the Alyth Burn.

With a capacity for up to 70 people it also has an adjacent kitchen suitable for the supply of snacks and soft drinks. There is a unisex toilet with both disabled and baby nappy changing facilities.

Quality seating for 60 plus is provided together a small conference table located on a small stage. The hall has many uses including a meeting place, rehearsal location, mothers & toddlers, jumble sales, etc.

There is suitable storage in separate rooms for regular users.

It is well lit and warm with a modern gas central heating system.
